

No article of clothing in the Indus Valley Civilization is as much a symbol of history, culture and native wisdom as Ajrak, a dexterously block printed cloth, dyed in natural agents tried and tested over centuries It has patterns that change meanings with slightest variations in color and design.

Over the centuries, the most common symbolism attached to Ajrak is as a shawl that marks honour, nobleness, and civility of its wearer; young or old, man, woman or child. Most commonly associated with the sartorial practices of communities living in today's province of Sindh of Pakistan.




Display of Woven Fabrics

Students of Advance Weave under the supervision of Mr. Shakeel Paracha displayed their products in the fountain area. The students put in a great effort in curating these products.








Display of Bridal Collection


































Fashion Show
















Product Display of Knitting & Technology TDT Year 3 Students
