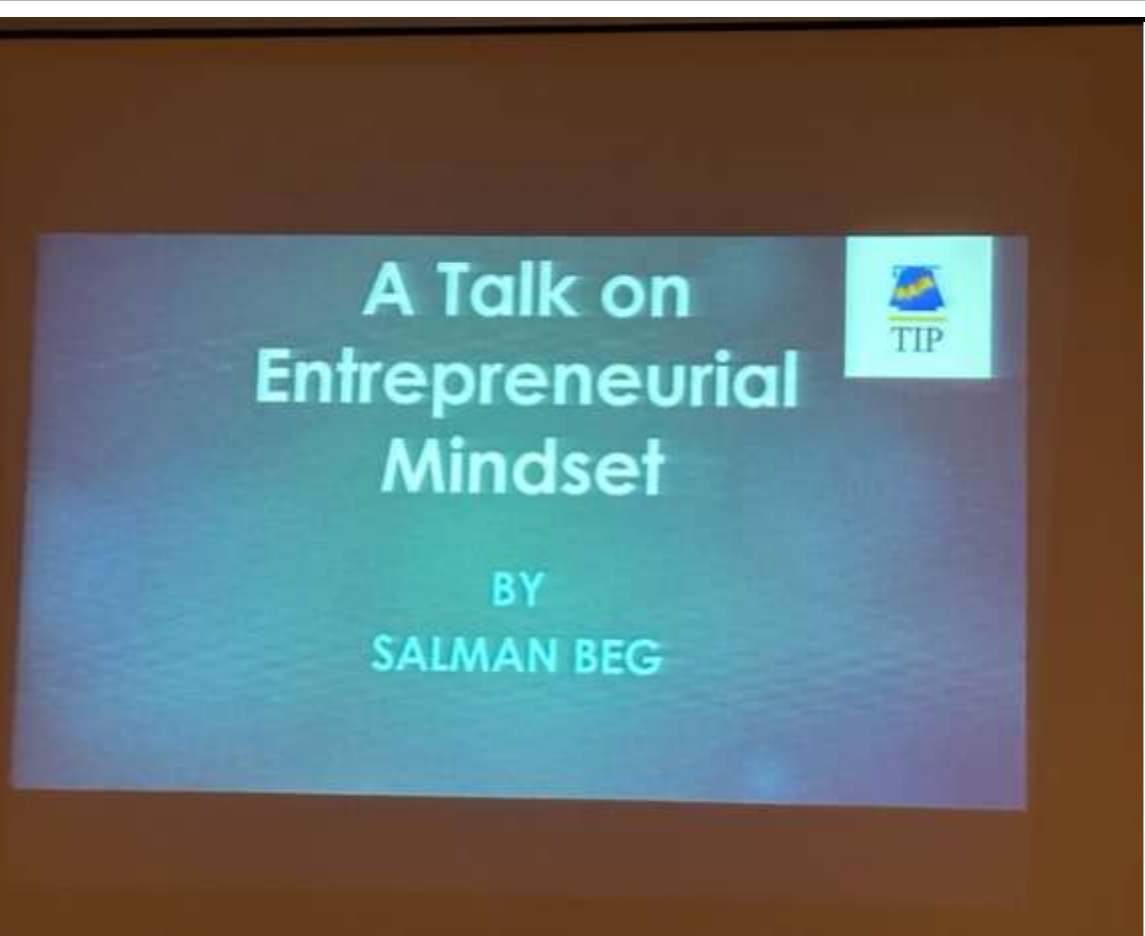




# Entrepreneurial Mindset by Mr. Salman Beg at TIP

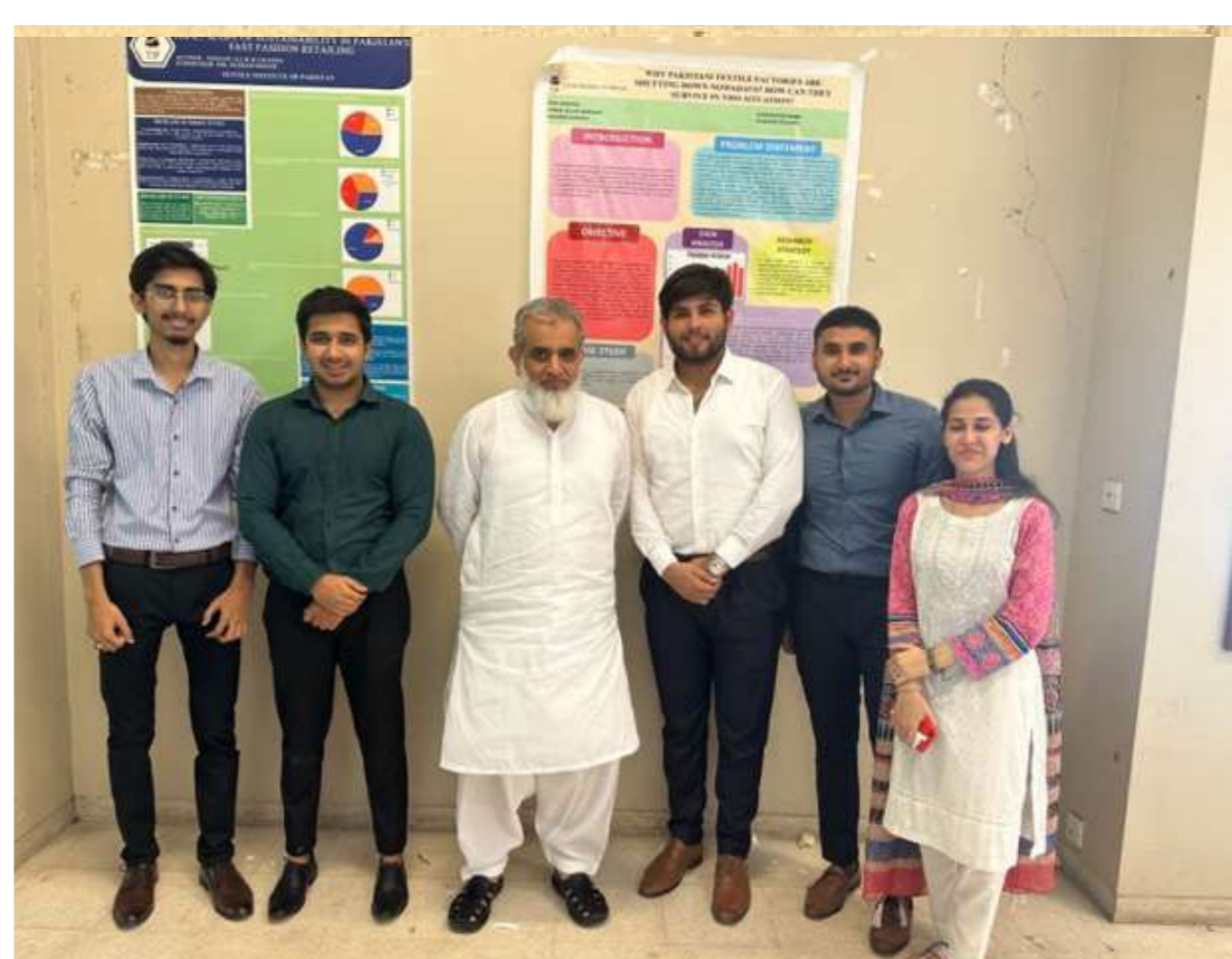
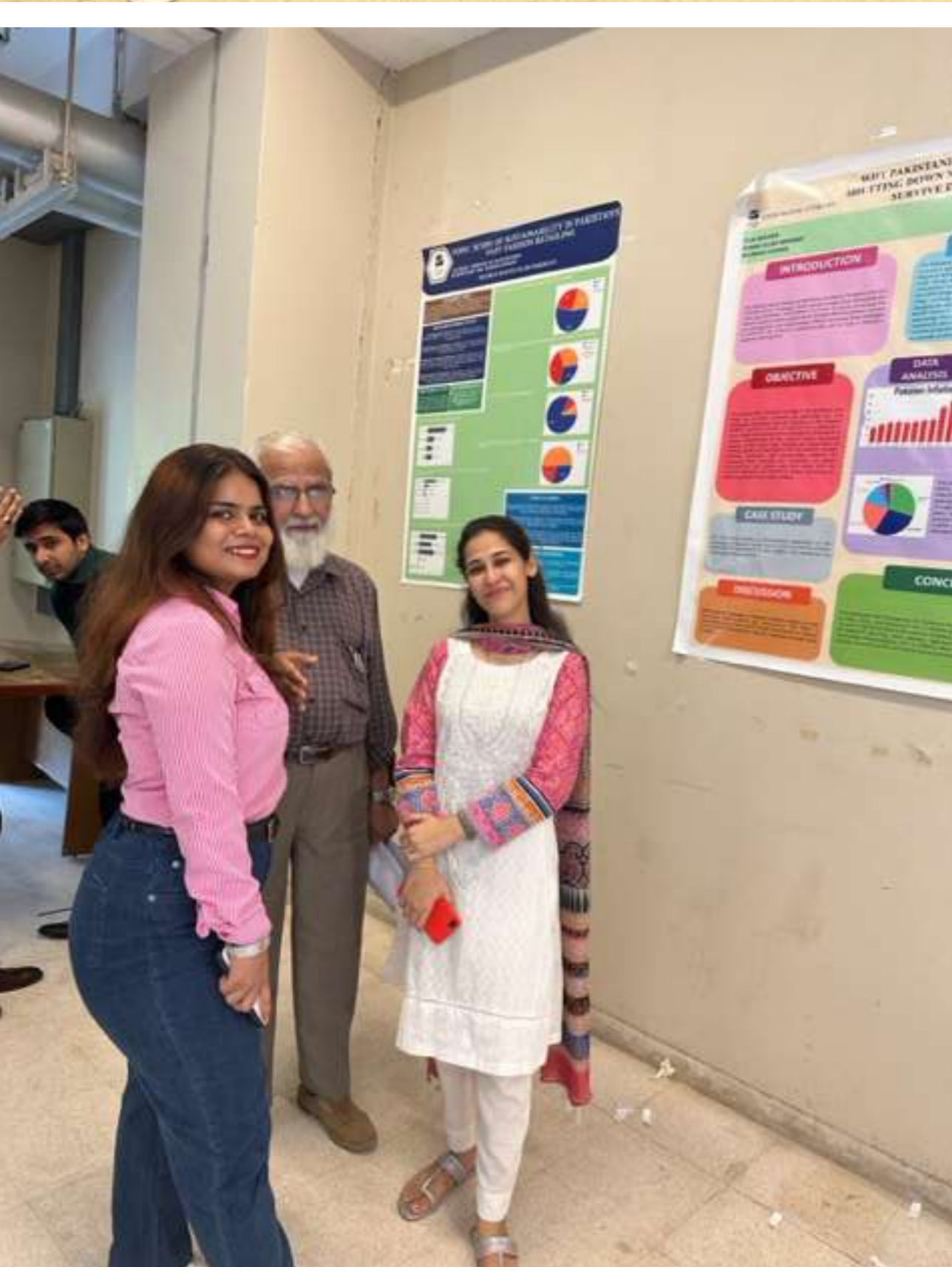
TDT 3 Students showcased their product display as a part of their assignment.
