No any seminar/workshop/conference have been arranged or participated during the reporting period.	The Dean/Coordinators are strictly directed to arrange seminar/workshop/conference in future and also encourage the faculty members to participate wherever such kind of activities is being held in the country.
Very limited text books are available for the faculty as well as for the students.	In addition to the existing number of Text Books, more books would be added in future.
