✓	The Mission Statement of the program was observed incomplete, similarly; No clear objectives and outcomes were available. The faculty, members unaware of the objective, outcomes and even Mission of the program.	The coordinator is advised to initiate review of the mission, objectives & outcomes of the program. After final approval, arrange few awareness seminars for the "Mission, Objectives & Outcomes" for the program.
✓	It was also observed that there was No clear future plan for the program.	The coordinator has been advised to make a very clear future plan with reference to the program.
✓	No highly qualified (PhD) faculty; No any National or International Awards have been won by the Faculty members so far. Similarly, no research activities and research articles were notified.	To hire new highly quailed faculty is under consideration & will be covered in the future.
✓·	Neither the department has arranged any seminar/workshop/conference nor did any faculty attend any such activity out of the institute.	The Dean/Coordinators are strictly directed to arrange seminar/workshop/conference in future and also encourage the faculty members to participate wherever such kind of activities is being held in the country.
✓	It was noticed that very less books were available for the faculty as well as for the students. Very less or no budget/contingency for the department for day to day expenditure.	In addition to the existing number of Text Books, more books have been added. More books will be added in future.
