The Textile Design Technology (TDT) Program:

Findings/weaknesses	KIND ACTION taken by the President
It was pointed out that there is very limited permanent faculty available.	Hiring permanent faculty is on priority of the TIP, soon more will be hired.
The curriculum was reviewed 3 years back, needs to be reviewed.	The curriculum has been reviewed in the 2019 and already in practiced from fall 2019.
There is a great need of the up gradation of the laboratories including latest computers for designing.	Laboratories have been upgraded; the computers for designing are now being used in the lab.
It was also suggested that the admission criteria to be reviewed and revised as per criteria guidelines of the NCRC/HEC.	Revision of the admission criteria is on agenda to be discussed before commencement of the coming academic year.
It was also noted that there is severe shortage of highly qualified faculty, while, current faculty to be encouraged to conduct research & publish research papers.	Recently one of the Faculty members (Ms. Shaheen Khan) has earned MS degree in the program. The faculty members are being encouraged to conduct research & get research findings published in the HEC recognized journals. One permanent & one visiting faculty of TDT have already enrolled in MS Program.
